



# Woodlawn Middle School's Reopening Information

Doors Open: 8:00 AM - Instruction Begins: 8:15 am – Dismissal: 2:45 pm

We are looking forward to transitioning to hybrid instruction! This is new for all of us, and we will continue to communicate important information and updates. Here are some important reminders to help you and your child prepare for returning to the building:

## Arrival & Dismissal Procedures:



- Beginning at 8:00 am, students will be allowed to enter through their grade level entrance.
- 6<sup>th</sup> Grade Entrance – Front doors
- 7<sup>th</sup> Grade Entrance – Nurse's Suite doors
- 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Entrance – Breezeway doors
- There will be breakfast stations near those entrances for any students that would like to take a breakfast.
- Students will move directly inside to their homeroom classes. No lockers will be utilized.
- Dismissal will be staggered by grade level

*\*Parents/guardians will not be permitted into the building.*

## Face Covering:

- Face coverings are required for all persons in a BCPS facility or vehicle as well as on BCPS property. Face coverings are required during transportation to/from school on a bus as well as outdoors on campuses.
- All students, employees, visitors and vendors must supply and wear their own face coverings while at or inside a BCPS owned building or vehicle.
- Properly wearing a face covering requires the person to cover both the nose and mouth with a face covering that fits snugly on the person's face without large gaps.
- No bandanas
- Students will not wear facemasks that are disruptive to the school environment, that promote illegal or harmful activities or that could endanger the health and safety of the student or other students.
- Each school, office, and school bus will have a supply of disposable face coverings for students and employees who forget their face covering or whose face covering becomes soiled or damaged.



## Screening & Stay Home When Appropriate:

- All employees and students are expected to screen themselves daily for symptoms of COVID-19.
- **Remain home** if you have symptoms, confirmed COVID-19 illness, had recent contact with a person with COVID-19 and/or awaiting test results.
- Parents will receive a screening checklist and magnet with the screening practices.

## Social Distancing:

- Classroom furniture is arranged to provide 6-foot separation between students.
- Reduce gathering of students in any area
- Floor tape, arrows and markers are on hallway floors to remind students to walk 6-feet apart and to stay to the right of the hallway
- No lockers will be used. Students are encouraged to only bring necessary items to school



## Hand Hygiene:

- Times for handwashing or use of hand sanitizer to include before and after meals, upon arrival to schools' offices and home, before and after use of any shared items, after use of the restroom, after sneezing/coughing and other time hands are contaminated.
- Hand sanitizer is available in all classrooms, offices, cafeteria and other spaces around the building.

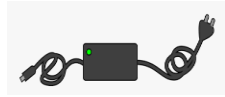


## Breakfast & Lunch:

- Breakfast will be packaged for students to "Grab and Go." Students will eat breakfast in their homeroom classroom.
- Students will eat lunch in the school cafeteria. Students will eat at desks which are currently spaced 6 ft. apart. Desks will be cleaned between each lunch shift.
- Breakfast and lunch will be available to all students at no cost. Students may choose to bring their own lunch from home.
- Parents will not be allowed to drop off lunch during the day.
- No food deliveries to students will be allowed.

### Supplies & Devices:

- Students will bring their devices to and from school each day.
- Please be sure devices are charged overnight. Students should pack their charging cord incase devices need to be charged throughout the day.



### Visitors:

- To visit a BCPS school, visitors must have an appointment.
- Visits will be conducted remotely or outside, whenever possible.
- If an indoor visit is required, visitors will be required to wear a face coverings and practice social distancing. Arrangements must be made in advance.
- The number of people admitted to the building will be limited.
- Parents will not be allowed to drop off lunch during the day.
- No food deliveries to students will be allowed.
